

College of Visual Arts & Design Minors, 2026-2027

Minors include a minimum of 18 semester hours of coursework in art, with at least 6 semester hours in advanced courses. At least 9 semester hours of art must be completed at UNT. A 2.50 grade point average is required in all minors. Additionally, a grade of "C" or above must be earned in all CVAD required courses. A grade of "D" or below will not satisfy any minor course requirements. Approved minor course sequences are listed below. Prerequisites are as stated in the catalog, unless otherwise noted.
