Important Notes:

- Please refer to the statement regarding “**Time to Degree Completion**” on Page 2.
- ADES 1550 is offered in fall semesters only. ADES 1560 and Entry Portfolio Review are offered in spring semesters only.
- ADES 3570 is being removed from the curriculum. It is no longer offered and should be replaced with an advanced elective.
- **Graduation Requirements:** Grades of “C” or better are required for all CVAD requirements. Additional graduation requirements include: 42 hours must be advanced; 24 of the 42 advanced hours must be completed at UNT. Must have a 2.0 GPA (UNT & overall) and a 2.5 GPA within the major. Entry Portfolio Review

Students interested in pursuing a major in Fashion Design begin as pre-majors. Admission to the Fashion Design major occurs through an entry portfolio review process at the end of the first year, for which students must meet minimum eligibility requirements to be considered, as follows:

Fashion Design Entry Review Eligibility (end of first-year spring semester)

- Completion of at least 30 hours of college courses;
- Completion of ART 1600, 1700, 1800, 1900; ADES 1550 & 1560, with grades of C or better;
- GPA of 2.50 or better on the required CVAD courses for eligibility;
- GPA of 2.25 or better on all courses completed at UNT; and
- Submission of all entry portfolio review materials by the deadline on the CVAD website listed below.

Details regarding the Fashion Design Portfolio Review requirement and timing are updated annually and are available on the [Fashion Design Entry Portfolio Review website](#).

Approximately 40 students will be selected from eligible entry review applicants for full admission into the Fashion Design major. All subsequent ADES coursework (sophomore level and higher) is restricted to those admitted as Fashion Design majors.

Transfer Credit

Students must submit official transcripts of all prior collegiate-level coursework as part of the UNT admissions process. Transfer information is reviewed with the student at Orientation. **Little to no transfer coursework is typically approved to transfer towards the required ADES coursework.** All students, regardless of academic status, must be admitted to the Fashion Design Program through the Fashion Design Portfolio Review.

Time to Degree Completion

Due to the highly sequenced curriculum and skill-building nature of coursework, ADES courses cannot be taken concurrently unless otherwise listed as such. This means that, regardless of the required total remaining credit hours, students should anticipate four years (8 fall/spring semesters) to complete the B.F.A. in Fashion Design, starting from the first ADES course completed (ADES 1550, fall semesters). ADES courses are not offered in summer semesters.

Students that do not successfully complete the review may, upon approval of department, re-review. However, this will delay the anticipated time to completion, typically by one year. Likewise, students that fail to successfully complete courses in sequence should anticipate a one-year delay in time to completion.
